- Looks at development trends, previously approved plans, demographic and economic data, and community perceptions
- Identifies specific recommendations and a Future Land Use Map that guide future development

FIRST SIX MONTHS

- January Organizational Meeting (City Staff & Benchmark)
- February Planning Commission Kickoff Meeting and Listening Sessions
- February April
 - Background research & analysis
 - Create a project website
 - Digital community survey posted on project & City websites
 - Meet Planning Commission to review background research
 - Hold a public kick-off event to gather initial public input

PLANNING COMMISSION ROLE

- Act as an advisory body to the City Staff and Consultant
- Review and discuss information, ideas, and recommendations prior to public presentation
- Assist with public outreach and engagement
- Final recommendation on Plan prior to advancing to Council
- Work with Council on implementation after adoption
